## Built for Regulated Markets

The EU AI Act regulates what you do with AI—not what kind of company you are. If you build models, embed AI into products, use AI in internal tools such as HR or lending, or offer AI services affecting the EU, you are in scope.

Even if headquartered outside Europe, or using a third-party model, you remain responsible for how it is applied. Any meaningful deployment, distribution, or modification of AI is an accountable act.
